Under Ohio law when you terminate your marriage, your ex-spouse is taken out of your Will. We read your Will as if your ex-spouse had predeceased you. However, your ex-spouse will receive your P&G retirement benefits and your life insurance if you do not change the beneficiary. Thus, it is critical to revise your estate plan after your marriage is terminated. It is particularly important to change the beneficiaries on your retirement accounts, IRAs, and life insurance policies.
